Set in the cultural heart of Brighton, just a few minutes from Brighton Station close to the fashionable North Laine Shopping District sits this entirely unique, top floor apartment with one double bedroom and a second mezzanine sleeping area. It has been beautifully renovated and designed to create a sweet hideaway elevated above the city centre, giving it exceptional views across the city in the east. It also boasts a quaint roof terrace area to the rear which catches the westerly sunshine during the afternoon, looking out over the cottages of Crown Gardens below.

Crown Gardens is a pretty twitten running behind the buildings of Queens Road characterised by cottages and gardens to one side, while the entrance to this building is on the other behind a secure gate. Stairs rise to the entrance to this flat which opens to a sweet hallway with the contemporary bathroom to the right. In here, the gleaming white bath suite has a shower over it, with walls tiled in stylish marbled grey to complement.

A couple of steps lead up to the corridor, culminating in the sitting room at the far end which has an amazing, vaulted ceiling with pendent lighting and a wide picture window framing wonderful, unexpected views over the treetops of the city to the east. It feels perfectly private as it is not overlooked by neighbouring homes and the skies light up with stars at night, to be enjoyed from your sofas. There is also space for formal dining and the kitchen is conveniently open plan with streamlined white cabinetry to include some integrated appliances while leaving space for a freestanding washing machine.

The double bedroom is next door, peacefully positioned to the rear of the building with a window looking out to the urban landscape. It is a fine size double room with freshly painted walls and soft carpet underfoot, with space for a double bed and wardrobes. There are two overhead cupboards, alongside fitted shelving which are ideal for clothes storage. A second sleeping area can be found above the corridor, accessed by ladder – ideal for guests coming to stay.


